What Is It? Can You Guess?

This plant was named the 2006 plant of the year.

This species is highly praised for its spicy clove-scented flowers which face upward for maximum color impact. They are produced prolifically above the silvery blue, 7-8 inch tall mats of evergreen foliage. It can grow well in either full sun or part shade. Due to its relatively short stature, it is an excellent plant for the front of the flower border. (visit www.horticare.net for the answer)

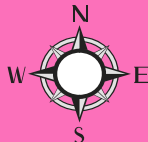
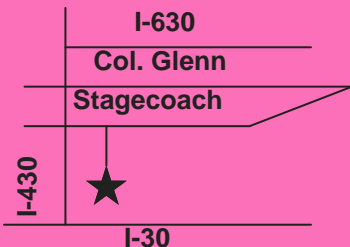
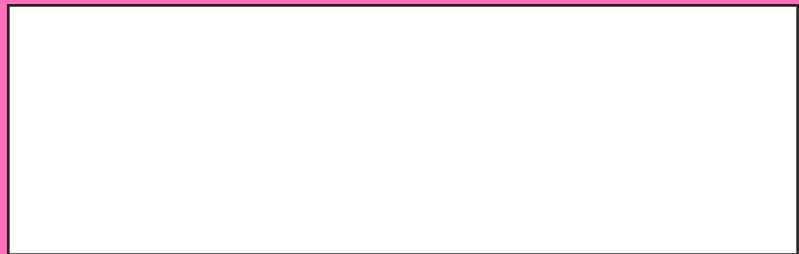
Our New Partnership!
